If you'd like to get more creative, there are lots of things you could try....

- Find your favourite story book and add sounds to it – vocal sounds, body sounds or using things from around the house.
- Take a well-known Nursery Rhyme (Infants) or song (Juniors) and try writing your own lyrics to it. This is also good for rhyming and syllable work as you try to get your words to fit!
- Download Garage Band onto your Ipad (class 4 have been using this) and start creating. You can either simply make some interesting music or use it as a backing track for some rapping! There is also a backing track on this page you can use.
