

2021 Infant Assessment

Because of the Coronavirus pandemic, all statutory assessment for primary school children was cancelled in 2020-21. However, the school used teacher assessment methods, including the use of past papers, to judge progress and the impact of school closures.

EYFS (8 in cohort)

In the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS), children are judged to be working towards the Early Learning Goal (emerging), achieving the Early Learning Goal (expected) or working beyond the Early Learning Goal (exceeding).

Writing

12% assessed at Emerging
88% assessed at Expected
38% assessed at Exceeding

Reading

12% assessed at Emerging
88% assessed at Expected
38% assessed at Exceeding

Maths

25% assessed at Emerging
75% assessed at Expected
13% assessed at Exceeding

Overall, 75% of pupils in the EYFS achieved a Good Level of Development.

Year 1 Phonics (17 in cohort)

The phonic screening check for June 2021 was cancelled, with schools expected to administer it during the autumn term instead.
