

2021 KS2 SATs results

Because of the Coronavirus pandemic, all statutory assessment for primary school children was cancelled in 2020-21. However, the school used teacher assessment methods, including the use of past papers, to judge progress and the impact of school closures.

When looking at how many children have succeeded in reaching expected standards for reading, writing and maths the results are as follows:

In addition, some children were judged to have worked beyond the expected standard by working at Greater Depth:

- Greater depth in reading: 29%
- Greater depth in writing: 7%
- Greater depth in maths: 29%

The most recent national average data is from July 2019.
