KEY INSTANT RECALL FACTS YEAR 4 – SPRING 2

I KNOW MY 12 X TABLE AND RELATED DIVISION FACTS

By the end of this term, children should be able to fluently recall multiplication and division facts for the 12 x table. They should be able to recall these numbers **instantly** (in the Year 4 tables check they have 6 seconds to answer times tables questions).

Children should be able to recall multiplication and division facts for the 12 x table.

Top tip: Here's a helpful trick for the 12 times table. To multiply by 12, we multiply by 10 the number we're going to multiply by 12 and then we add double the original number to the result.

So, for 8 x 12 =, do

 $8 \times 10 = 80$

Double 8 = 16

Add 80 and 16 together to make 96

 $8 \times 12 = 96$
